AEROSOL PAINT CANS

- Began 2nd QTR 2015
- Recycled 2,680lbs of aerosols paint cans
- Completely recouped the cost of the unit
- Provided an additional ~\$1,800.00 in cost savings to date
- Over 10,000lbs of scrap metal recycled in 2016





RIGID PLASTICS

- 5 gal Buckets: Began 2-3rd QTR 2015
- Less space used in the latex roll-off
- #2 HDPE Antifreeze 2nd QTR 2016
- Increased landfill diversion,
Increased cost savings
- Since 2015 almost 9,000lbs of plastics recycled





ZERO WASTE FUNDING PROGRAM GRANT

- May 2016 the HMMF received a grant from Boulder County Recycling Center Zero Waste Funding Program, funding two pilot programs
- Began a residential sharps program, utilizing Colorado Medical Waste for disposal
- Purchased mailers, allowing small volumes of Schedules II,III,IV, V meds to be disposed of, at no cost to residents, by Sharps Compliance, Inc.
