CAFR RECEIVES WEYERHAEUSER COMPANY FOUNDATION GRANT

(Denver, Colorado) – The Colorado Association for Recycling received a \$5,000 grant from Weyerhaeuser Company Foundation for support of the 2008 Summit for Recycling in Aspen.

The annual Summit for Recycling is the only statewide conference dedicated to sharing information about recycling, remanufacturing, reuse and reprocessing. Each year, hundreds of people associated with the recycling industry gather to learn, educate, share data and ideas, network, renew contacts and improve their understanding of recycling and the specific challenges we face in Colorado. This year, participants at the Summit for Recycling had the opportunity to learn about furthering statewide standards for composting, establishing a regional approach to electronics recycling, recycling's role in climate change, the basics of recycling, recycling markets, and much more. Exhibits were set up in the main exhibit hall enabling sponsors and exhibitors to more fully engage in the program.
